2015 results

I am so proud to be able to talk to you about this year's results. Across the school we have had our best results for years. This is testament to the hard work of both your children and the staff. We'd also like to thank you for all your support to the school and your children.

Foundation Stage

Our Good Level of Development score for this year is 65% which is above the Local Authority percentage.

Key Stage One

The phonics screening test results are 79% passed. This an 8% improvement on the school's score last year and above national score.

Our Year 2 results in Reading, Writing and Maths are all in line with or above last year's national scores.

Key Stage Two SATs

In KS2 the Year 6 children surpassed themselves. In all areas they have risen to the challenge and performed brilliantly. Well done Year 6 and all the staff involved.

We are so proud that this year, for the first time anyone at school can remember, every child achieved level four in Reading. This means every child leaves our school achieving the nationally expected level which means they are all able to go to their secondary schools able to make great progress there at the national expectation or better.

Across all subjects, expected progress was 98% making expected progress. This is better than the national average.
