## 2016 results

I am so proud again to be able to talk to you about this year's results. The new assessments this year, as part of the new national curriculum, have been very challenging for pupils and staff but they all worked very hard and did a superb job. We'd also like to thank you for all your support to the school and your children.

### Foundation Stage

Our Good Level of Development score was 64.4% which is above the district percentage.

### Key Stage One

The phonics screening test results were 74% passed. This a slight dip, representing one child less than last year.

Our Year 2 results in Reading, Writing and Maths were all well down from 2015 due to the new assessments. This is a pattern reflected across the country.

### Key Stage Two

In KS2 the Year 6 children did a superb job with the challenging new SATs tests. Well done Year 6 and all the staff involved.

The much higher expectations mean that our attainment scores have dropped significantly, as they have with most schools. Our progress scores for Reading and Maths were in line with national figures showing how well our children did from their starting points. Only our writing progress scores were lower which is, unfortunately, one of the issues caused by the massive problems with the inaccuracy of teacher assessments across the entire country this year.
