## **2017 results**

I am so proud again to be able to talk to you about this year's results. The new assessments, as part of the new national curriculum, continue to be very challenging for pupils and staff but they all worked very hard and did a superb job. These assessments are increasingly highlighting the importance of reading regularly at home with your child and exposing them to a broad a vocabulary as possible as this is often where our pupils struggle when compared to others.

### **Foundation Stage**

Our Good Level of Development score was up to 69% which is above the district and local authority percentages but 2% below national. From the children's starting points when they joined us this represents excellent progress.

### **Key Stage One**

The phonics screening test results were 73% passed. This a slight dip, representing the same number of children passing but an additional child in the cohort. This is slightly below local authority and national and an area we are working on to further improve.

Our Year 2 results in Reading, Writing and Maths were all in line with national for expected and above

### **Key Stage Two SATs**

In KS2 the Year 6 children did a superb job with the challenging SATs tests. Well done Year 6 and all the staff involved.

The continued much higher expectations mean that our attainment scores are still below where we would like them. We were especially disappointed with the Reading score as we expected 69% of our children to pass, based on the practice tests they had completed.

Unfortunately the massive problems with teacher assessment of writing across the entire country continued this year which see our improvements still leading to a negative progress score. In a pilot of comparative judgement our school is participating in, our children scored 74%, only slightly below national.
