Following our letter before Christmas about our change to maths and English groups in the spring term <u>3-4mathsenglish2023.pdf</u> (edgewoodprimaryschool.co.uk), we are writing now to let you know some more details.

Children will continue to come in through the gate and be registered with their normal classes and go to assembly. After assembly they will then go to their maths groups. They will go back to their class before and after morning break and before lunchtime so these groups will not affect any other part of their school day. PE and other lessons in the afternoon will be totally unaffected by their morning groups.

The catch-up tutoring will also continue throughout the spring term.

We believe this will be the most effective way to support all our 3/4 pupils to catch up on the learning they lost through the pandemic and to boost their academic achievement and ensure they are set up well for a very successful time throughout Key Stage Two.
