## How to help your child's learning at home:

- Read at least 3 times a week at home.  
It is very important that children have a chance to practise their phonics/ reading skills regularly at home. Your child can read a range of things; it doesn't just have to be a school reading book. They may choose to read a magazine, recipe or one of their own books.
- Practise their spellings with them.
- Help them to practise and learn their number bonds and times tables.
- Discuss the Vocabulary Ninja words with your child each day.

## Topics for this half term

Our new topic for this term is based on the human body and is called 'All About Me'.

Maths: Place value, addition, subtraction, money, multiplication, division & graphs.

English: Story writing (based on Handa's Surprise) and instruction writing.
