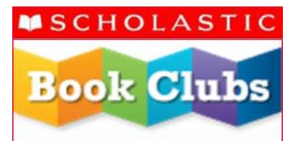
### Book Swap Friday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2018



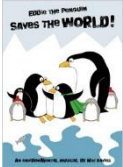
