### Odd Socks Day



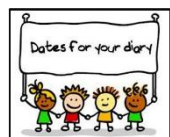

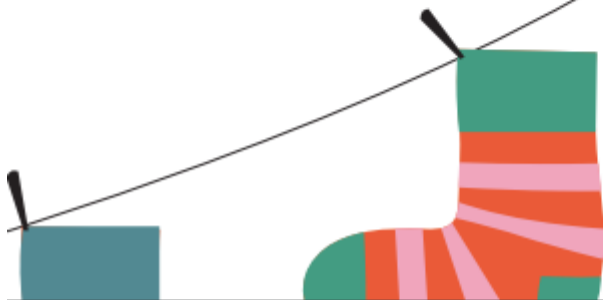
