## **SEND Outcomes Survey**

During the first half of 2024, the key focus of the local area partnership will be to develop an outcome based strategy to deliver our long-term and sustainable improvements to the SEND system in Nottinghamshire, which will lead to improved outcomes for children and young people with SEND. Following work undertaken by local area leaders last term a short survey has been developed seeking feedback on six proposed outcomes for Nottinghamshire. The survey is intended to be completed by leaders, practitioners including teachers, children, and young people with SEND and their parents and carers. The survey's closing date is Wednesday 31 January 2024. The survey's feedback will be used to determine the final outcomes which will form the basis of the local area's SEND Strategy to be published in July 2024.


## **Deadline for application to start Reception in September 2024**
