### **Uniform Policy**



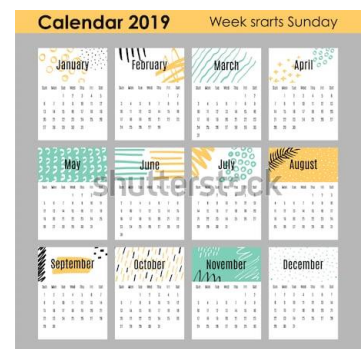
It has been brought to our attention that a few children are not complying with the uniform policy, specifically with regards to the colour of their hair. May I please draw your attention to the following extract from the policy:
