# **Reminder regarding Uniform**

#### School PE kit on PE days

All children will continue to wear their school PE kit on the days they are due to have PE.

This has saved hours of time over the year in PE lessons meaning your children are getting all their time doing PE rather than changing. It has also massively reduced the lost property or clothing mix-ups on those days.

The P.E. kit for all students consists of:

- Plain Black shorts or Joggers
- Plain red t-shirt
- Dark trainers (or plimsolls) (Not brightly coloured trainers)
- Children may also wear their red school jumper on cold days.

Please ensure your child is sent in correct PE uniform, not sports tops or other

#### School Uniform

As a reminder, we have noticed an increasing number of children being sent to school not in the correct uniform. Staff will be contacting parents of pupils sent in incorrect uniform to come and remedy any issues.

The uniform for all students should be selected from the following:

- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt
- Grey or black trousers
- Grey or black skirt or pinafore
- Red jumper/sweatshirt or cardigan
- Red and white summer dress
- Black shoes (NOT trainers)

Polo shirts and sweaters with the school logo are available to purchase from Hucknall Sports on the High Street. However, any white shirt and red jumper are absolutely fine to wear.
