To be eligible for a government funded place your child **MUST** be in receipt of Benefits related Free School Meals and be at least 5 years of age (or if 4 must already be in Reception class at school).

Children will be provided with a healthy breakfast and afternoon snack but are required to bring their own lunch. All of our food options have been approved by the HAF team and are nutritionally balanced and support the healthy eating education that we will be providing.
