Congratulations also go to Rosa and Orange class for a whole year attendance of 96.61%



Learning with parents

Next academic year, we will be launching a new way to record your child's reading at home. This has been successfully trialled in Key Stage 1 during the summer term and will be rolled out to all classes when we return. In September, you will receive a link from Learning with Parents – this will be sent as an email or text (please check your junk folders for the link if you do not receive one.) There is no need to register; each week you will receive a new link to record your child's reading. You will also have the opportunity to upload any pictures or audio and write any comments if you wish. Your child's class teacher will check the reading log at least weekly – we ask that children are reading at least 4x each week at home. Please see the poster below for further information.
