Sports Day



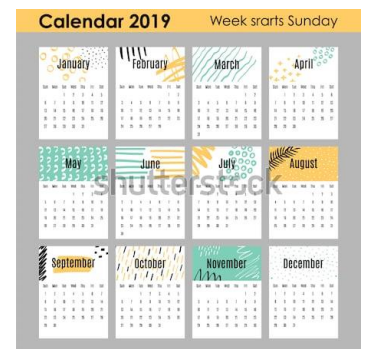

It would appear that we have some budding athletes in our school. Keep an eye out in the future for their names and remember you saw them here first!

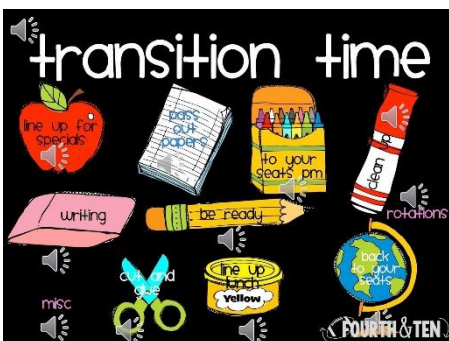
Dates for the Diary
