Edgewood Strikes Gold for 4th Consecutive Year!



We are delighted to announce that Edgewood Primary School has achieved the School Games Gold Mark Award for the 2024/25 academic year – marking the fourth consecutive year we have achieved this award.

The School Games Mark is a government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.

A special thanks to all our amazing children who have embraced all the opportunities we have given them this year and to all the staff and team at Next Level Sports who support us with all aspects of our sporting offer.

We look forward to applying once again in 2026, where we will aim to achieve our Platinum Award (5 consecutive years of the Gold Award) for the first time in the school's history.

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
