Please be aware that we have had an instance this week with a child choking on a fruit winder. Thanks to the very quick thinking of the children on their dinner table and the staff this was dealt with swiftly and with no harm. These winders say they are a potential choking hazards for children under 36 months, but the child was obviously older than that. Please be vigilant when sending any items in packed lunch boxes that can represent a choking risk and ensure that grapes are sliced in half for any child 5 or below.
