Maths:

Weeks	Context	Key Objectives (or other significant objectives)
WC 18 th April	2D/ 3D shape/ Fractions of shapes & numbers	Yr 1: Recognise and name common 2-D & 3-D shapes. Yr 2: Describe properties of 2-D shapes, including number of sides and symmetry.
WC 25 th April	2D/ 3D shape/ Fractions of shapes & numbers	Yr 2: Describe properties of 3-D shapes, including number of edges, vertices and faces. Yr 1: Recognise, find and name a half and a quarter. Yr 2: Recognise, find, name and write $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of size, shape or quantity. Yr 2: Write simple fraction facts.
WC 2 nd May (4 day week)	Target grouping – test preparation and problem solving	All objectives previously taught this academic year will be revised. Yr 2 groups will be using the rising stars mock test as a starting point for learning and teaching. Yr 1 groups will be carrying out a range of problem solving activities to develop using and applying skills.
WC 9 th May (Spelling SATs)	Target grouping – test preparation and problem solving	
WC 16 th May (Maths tests x 2 & SPAG test).	Yr 1 observation opportunities Yr 2 problem solving	Year 2 children will complete their SATs tests & carry out a range of problem solving activities to develop their using and applying skills. Yr 1 children will be given a range of activities that will allow teacher to observe and assess their skills.
WC 23 rd May (4 day week)	Test recap	SATs tests carried out will form the basis of each session allowing children to revisit questions they may have found tricky and work with the teacher to decide on a more appropriate method.
