English

The children will be reading **The Lost Happy Endings** and will complete some descriptive writing around both characters and settings before

then writing their own new ending for this dark and intriguing fairy tale.

As a class, we will be reading I Was There: Titanic by Margi McAllister in our guided reading lessons.



Physical Education

Children should come to school in their P.E. kit on the following days:

Verde - every Monday.

Rosa and Amarillo Classes -every Tuesday.

They should wear black bottoms, a red top and a red jumper or cardigan.

Geography

Our geography lessons will continue to look at the human and physical features of Campania, Italy and then we will look at how this compares to our region here in the UK.

Science and Religious Education

During our **science** lessons, we will be learning about sound. The children will identify how sounds are made, to recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear and find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it. They will use data loggers to create a line graph and analyse their results. Then, they will learn about plants.

In our **religious education** lessons, the children will be looking at rituals and beliefs around births, marriages and deaths, including beliefs of the afterlife and humanist celebrations.

Spanish

In Spanish, the children are learning about the word "se" and some common verbs. They will form longer and more complex sentences using the conjunctions 'y' (and) & 'pero'.

Computing

(programming)

The children will use Publisher to explore desktop publishing and create a magazine cover. They will also use our Micro:bit computers to study sound. Compare equivalent fractions and u

lessons:

- Compare equivalent fractions and use this knowledge to write fractions in their simplest form.
- Learn to represent improper fractions as mixed numbers.

Mathematics

We will cover the following objectives in our maths

Learn about unit and non-unit fractions.

- Compare numbers with the same number of decimal places.
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change.

PSHE (RSE) and D&T

In our **PSHE lessons**, our topic is Being Safe. The children will explore how to stay safe in their local environment, near roads, rail or water. They will learn how to keep safe around medicines and illegal substances and what to do in an emergency.

In our **D** & **T** lessons, the children will be sewing a purse or pencil case.

Weekly Homework (due every Thursday)

Homework will be assigned every Friday.

- Maths Shed: Every week, children will complete a times table test in the classroom. On Maths Shed, they will be assigned the times table they are focusing on for their weekly test. They should complete 5 games. <u>https://www.mathshed.com/en-gb/</u>
- **Spellings:** Children will complete a weekly spelling test. The spellings will be assigned every Friday and they should complete **5 games**. <u>https://www.spellingshed.com/en-gb/</u>
