

Year 3/4 Summer Term 2

Even though it will be the last half term of the year, we still have lots to learn!

The main focus for each subject after half term will be as follows:

English – Children will be developing their sentences through writing the story for a short animated film clip. We hope to invite parents/carers into school again so children can share their writing with you.

Maths – We will finish calculating money and then spend two weeks learning about capacity and weight. We will then finish the year looking at 2D and 3D shapes. Times tables will continue to be practised daily.

Science – The digestive system and the importance of healthy foods. We will be looking at the nutritional content of cereal bars and making our own.

Geography – Global weather, climate and biomes. Lots of Atlas work.

Computing – Using Movie Maker to create short animation film clips.

Art – Graffiti, focussing on famous British graffiti artists such as Banksy and Ben Eine.

Music – Learning the lyrics and playing instruments to Bob Marley's Three Little Birds.

PE – Field and Strike games such as Rounders.

RE/PSHE – Transition, moving on and making new friends.

Over the half term break we encourage the children to be inquisitive and speak to people and research into some of their new topics. We hope that they can then share their ideas and thoughts with the rest of the class.
