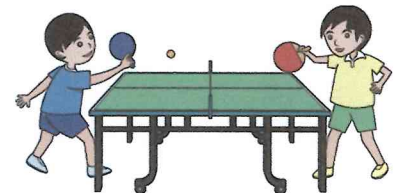
Indoor Rowing Years 5 & 6

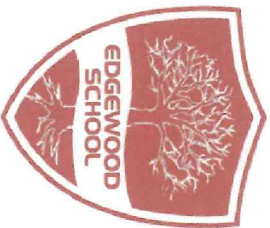
Everyone Active – Free Activities for U17's
