## **YMCA before and after school club at Edgewood Primary School**

YMCA childcare will be continuing to deliver our before and after school club when school starts back in September.

Our club is open to all children aged 4 to 12 years and allows children to do what they do best, use lots of energy, make new friends and most of all have fun.

The before school club starts at 7.15am and we ask carers to sign the children in before 8.20am in order to give the children time to have breakfast. Each booked session costs £3.50.

The after school club starts straight after school and runs until 6.00pm and costs £7.50 per session. During the after school club children are provided with a healthy snack and have the chance to take part in a wide range of activities such as sports, games and crafts.
