Netball - Well done to the girls involved in the netball tournament on Monday. Great work led to a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish and a **silver** for the school!


**Basketball** – On Wednesday, a team qualified for the local basketball final. Well done to the team, who won one match and lost a tight final!
