In today's assembly we joined the national minute's silence in remembrance of those who lost their lives in Manchester. This was also an opportunity for us to think about those who help in such situations and to give thanks for their efforts, from the emergency services to those who rallied round afterwards.

As a school, we always try to tackle such issues sensitively, and once again have drawn on the training our staff received from the Education Psychology Service earlier this year. Class teachers take an approach suited to the age of the children in their classes, which is based on the principle that an honest approach is much better than children feeling confused or left with unanswered questions.
