### YEAR 5 & 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP- WALESBY FOREST

5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021

Before we set off on our residential trip to Walesby Forest, I am writing to inform you of some final arrangements.

We will have lunch when we arrive at the Activity Centre. Please ensure your child has a packed lunch for Monday 5<sup>th</sup> July. If you need a school packed lunch, please order this on the ipay system. Your child will also need a drinks bottle, which they will use during the week. These should be in a small backpack to take onto the coach. The small backpack will also be used to carry sun cream, hats, insect repellent and waterproofs during the week while doing the activities.

Please check that your child has sufficient suitable clothing and a waterproof jacket/coat. Most activities require children to have their arms and legs covered so please ensure they have long-sleeved shirts/ tops and long trousers. Please bear in mind that most clothing is likely to get dirty due to the nature of the activities. A copy of the kit list is attached to this letter for your reference. If possible, use one bag or suitcase.

The centre will be providing sheets, duvets and pillows.

Children are allowed to bring some sweets in a named container. Be mindful that they are only at the centre for 4 nights and will not need too many. We will control the amount of sweets that are given to children but they will bring home any that are not eaten.

Please ensure that any medicines are named, and handed to Mrs Craske on the morning of our departure.

If there are new medicines that need to be added to the consent forms, this must be done before we leave or we will not be able to administer them. If your child requires travel sickness medication for the return journey, please ensure that this is on the consent form. To help with the organisation, please do this before Monday morning. Please contact school as soon as possible to arrange this.

The coach will be **leaving Edgewood at 11:30am**. We ask that you **arrive at school from 11:00 am onwards**. Please enter school through the main entrance.

We plan to arrive back at school during the afternoon, on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July. I expect that you will be able to collect your child from school between 2:30pm and 3:30pm from the school reception. We will contact you if there are any changes to this arrangement due to traffic conditions. Also, all medicines will need to be collected by an adult at this time.

Please be aware that when we arrive back at school, we will require all children to go into school before being collected. So that the coach can park close to school, we ask that you leave space on Christchurch Road near the construction site (old Harrier site).

# RESIDENTIAL KIT LIST 2021



## ONE large bag or case with:

**Please label all clothing**

**Waterproof coat** 

Thick long socks for boots (Enough for every day)

Socks for normal use (Enough for every day) NOT trainer socks

Outdoor shoes (trainers or walking boots)

These are very likely to get very muddy

Indoor shoes (trainers or slippers)

Wellington boots (optional)

**Long trousers and long-sleeved shirts** for activities / evenings / cold weather (tracksuit trousers are ok **NOT** jeans)

Shorts and t-shirts for general wear on warm days

Warm jumpers/sweatshirts/fleeces

Swimwear and old clothes/ trainers for water activities

Nightwear

Underwear (Enough for every day and spares!)

Wash kit

Towels (at least 2)

Sun Hat(s)

Sun cream – enough for the week, preferably once a day

Lip balm / Lip  ck

Insect repellent

Torch



Please note: your child will use this rucksack to carry their belongings (sun cream, hats, water bottle etc.) to activities during the week.

### One small bag or rucksack for:

Packed lunch

Camera- Not a phone



Water bottle to use during the week

(Especially important with Covid so they aren't using cups)

### Medicines- named and handed to Mrs Craske as you arrive at school.

**DO NOT** pack in bags please.

### Money

(It only sells sweets and small souvenirs)

***Please DO NOT bring radios/mobile phones***



**You may bring a reading book, an activity book or comic for the journey and the evenings.**
