Year 6 NTU Trip

You should have received a link to a letter about Monday's trip. Please note that due to the very high temperatures expected on Monday, children are encouraged to come to school in non-uniform (see today's letter about Red Extreme Heat Warning for more details).

Year 6 Leavers' Party

This year's leavers' party will take place straight after school on Tuesday 19th July. Even though children will be in non-uniform on Tuesday, Year 6 children will be able to bring a change of clothes for the party if they wish. As the weather is set to be very hot, please ensure that your child comes to school with suntan lotion, a hat and a water bottle.

We will start the party with some games and this will be followed by a buffet and drinks for all the children. If your child would like to bring their mobile phone with them to take pictures at the party, it must be handed in to the office at the beginning of the day. While we encourage the children to take photographs of each other, it is important to note that these must only be for personal use and must not be shared on social media under any circumstances as we do not have permission for photos to be shared in this way.

The children will need to be picked up from the gate normally used by Rojo class (at the top of the playground) at 5pm. You should soon receive a text link to a form where you will need to confirm whether your child will be attending the party and if they are going to walk home by themselves or be collected by an adult.
