Dear parents / carers,

At Edgewood Primary School we follow the Monster Phonics programme to support children in their developing reading and writing skills. Monster Phonics uses visual clues based on a coloured coded system to engage children – the children love learning all about the monsters and the sounds they represent.

This programme will be launched in Foundation at the very start of your child's phonics journey, and continues through to the end of Key Stage 1. Phonics is such an important part of our curriculum, it is taught daily and it builds the foundation of children's reading and writing.

To spark a love of phonics and reading we would like to have a Monster Phonics dress up day on **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October**. This will be an opportunity for your child to come dressed in either the colour of their favourite monster, or to dress up as their favourite monster from the scheme. The monsters are pictured below so you can see what they look like and what colour they are. Remember – it is fine to just dress up as the colour of their favourite monster:

Angry Red A – red  
Green Froggy – green  
Yellow I – Yellow  
Miss Oh No – pink  
U-Hoo – purple  
Cool Blue – blue  
Brown Owl – brown  
Silent Monsters – white  
Tricky – black/gold  
Black Cat – black
