Please remember to report absences for children daily – even if we have sent them home the day before. Thank you.



Design and Technology – Cooking and Nutrition Week

On the last week before half term, the children took part in our whole school cooking and nutrition week. Each cohort was given a skill to practise and they were able to choose any dish to make for the rest of the school to taste. EYFS had a wonderful time mixing to make Rice Krispy cakes! KS1 learnt to use the bridge grip and fork hold to chop up fruit for a delicious fruit salad. YR 3&4 rolled their sleeves up to practise kneading and shaping pinwheel cookies, whilst YR5&6 learnt to use the hob to cook a chunky vegetable stew.

The children all worked incredibly hard and followed their instructions superbly to ensure we had no missing fingers at the end of it! It was a fantastic week, learning new skills and tasting a variety of foods. Well done Edgewood.



ASDA REWARDS

Children in Need

This year, we will be raising vital funds for Children in Need during the week commencing 11th November ahead of the Children in Need appeal show on Friday 15th November.

After last year, when we raised over £4000, we can't wait to see how we get on this year.

During the week, your child will be completing a <u>runPudsey</u> activity in their PE sessions as well as completing the final part of their challenge during Friday's celebration assembly. To raise funds for Children in Need, we are asking that your child gets sponsored to complete these challenges – <u>you will need to register your child using the details below, where you will create your child's very own online sponsorship page</u>. Every child that registers online to complete the event will receive a special runPudsey medal directly from Children in Need (providing there is a donation on their page – no matter how small). If you are registering siblings, you will be able to add those on so you only have to register once per family.

On Friday 15th November, we are also inviting children to come to school in as many spotty items as possible to celebrate the theme 'Spotacular' as part of our Children in Need celebrations.

Steps to register my child for runPudsey:

- 1. Visit https://www.runpudsey.co.uk/dmz/register-school and click 'Register as a parent'.

- **3.** Fill in parent details and complete signup.
- 4. Collect sponsorship via their personal online fundraising page.

<u>Without registering online – your child will not receive their medal from Children in Need</u> (these will be sent to school once the event has been completed).
