### **Uniform**

Polo shirts and sweaters with the school logo are available to purchase from Hucknall Sports on the High Street. However, **any white shirt and red jumper are acceptable.**

As we are a primary school, we do not allow the wearing of hair dye, make-up or nail varnish. If these are used outside of school, please ensure that they are removed before school returns.
