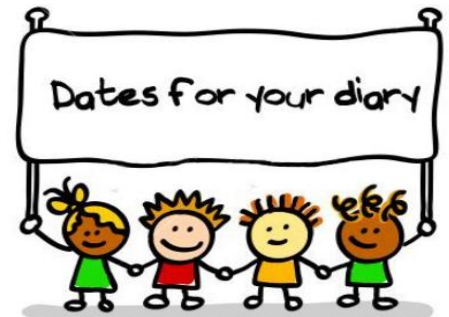

School admissions consultation

The County Council, as the admission authority for community and voluntary controlled schools, is required by the School Admissions Code to determine admission arrangements annually. Any changes have to be consulted upon prior to determination.

This year, the consultation for the admission arrangements for 2026-2027 for all community and voluntary controlled schools in Nottinghamshire will be open between 3 October 2024 and 24 November 2024. A summary of the consultation is attached, and the full proposed arrangements are available on the council website www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/admissionsconsultation

It is important that all consultees have an opportunity to comment on the proposed arrangements if they wish to do so; comments can be made up to 24 November 2024 by doing either of the following:
