- Check your child's hair once a week.
- Please use a proper detection comb and if you find live lice, consult a pharmacist to check the whole family.

It is the same website as for children but you just add your age to get to the right information.
- Bottled Up Blokes #TALKITOUT Specifically for men: this is a peer support group or football
  support session run within the community by volunteers. You may already be aware of it as one of
  the peer support groups, Bub Hubs, runs in Hucknall each Tuesday. There are also football sessions
  at Tibshelf and Bilborough small-sided games and booking required via the website. The sessions
  look to be free, although the website asks for donations to keep them running.
