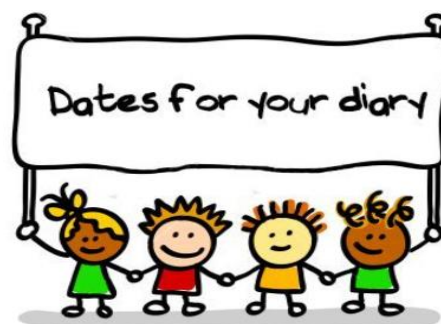
Congratulations to Orange class for a weekly attendance of 98.33%

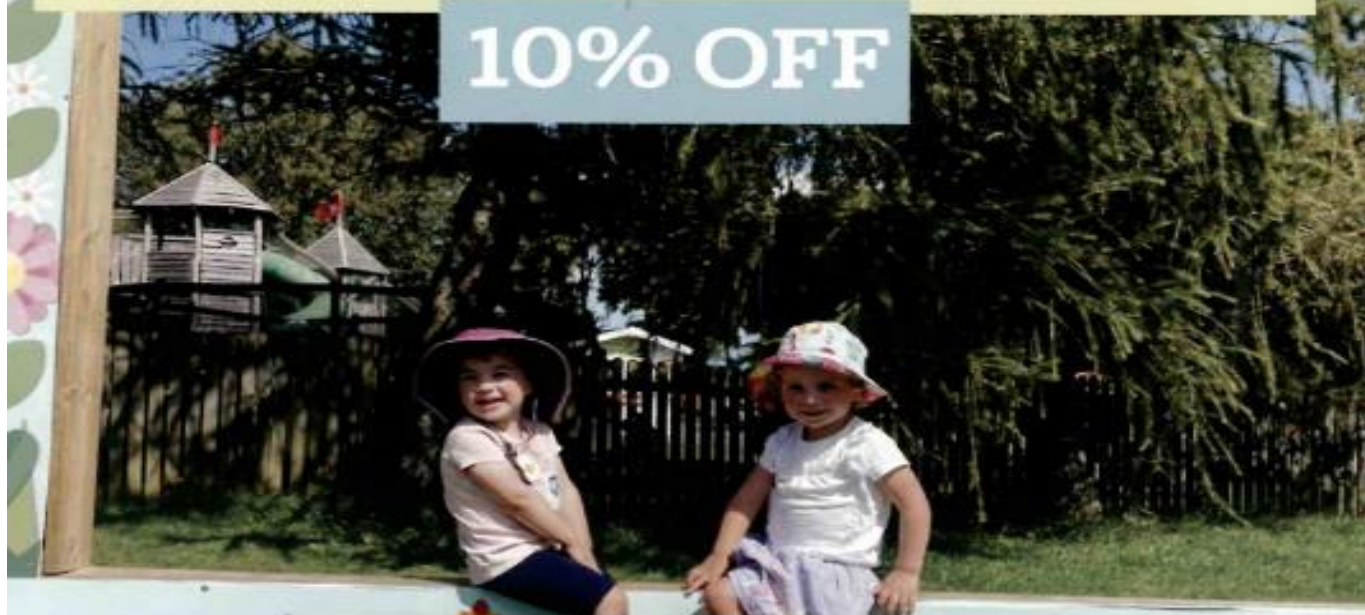
