Please remember to report absences for children daily – even if we have sent them home the day before. Thank you.

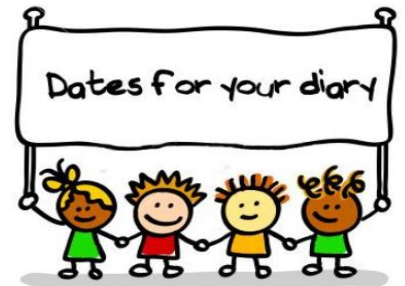
