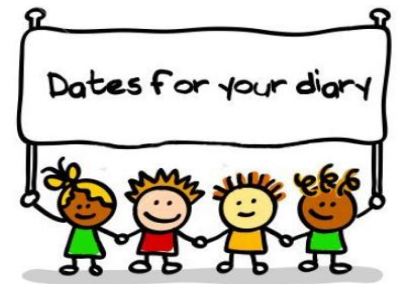
Congratulations to Rojo class for a weekly attendance of 98.67%
