

School Neurodiversity

In September 2024, our school will be participating in the Partnership for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools Project (PINS), closely supported by the Nottinghamshire Parent Carer forum (PCF). Through collaboration, the project will bring health and education specialists and expert parent carers into our school to provide training to improve outcomes for our children.

To support preparations for this project we would be very grateful if you could complete the survey below. The parent carer survey has been developed nationally and is designed to gather insights from parents and carers of



children attending the schools involved in the PINS project. The information collected will help to understand the current strengths and identify potential areas for improvement within the school environment. The survey intentionally covers broad aspects of school life, parent carers' experiences, and their views on their child's experience at school.

Our school will receive an overview of the results, however, please be assured feedback given is completely anonymised. The survey will be open to ALL parent carer response from 28th June – 12th July.

Holiday Activity and Food programme (HAF)

Nottinghamshire County Council will start to take bookings for the 2024 Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF) on Monday 1st July, ready for the summer holidays. HAF provides FUNDED activities and food for children receiving benefits related free school meals. These programmes run during the following school holidays: spring (Easter), summer, autumn (October) and Christmas holidays.

Children aged between 5 - 16 years (Reception aged 4 and year 11 inclusive) in receipt of benefits related free school meals are eligible for free holiday activities and food. This is not a food voucher scheme; all activities happen face to face.
